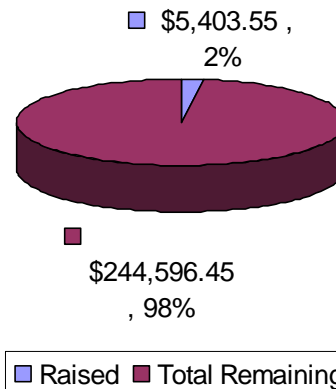

The Royal Canadian Legion, Sir William Stephenson, Branch 637 of Oshawa, Ontario is attempting to purchase Historic Treasures before they become lost to us forever.

This proclaimed privately owned collection, includes articles from the top secret Camp X spy training school, and is up for sale and in danger of leaving Canada.

Items from Camp X, near the Whitby/Oshawa border where allied agents trained during WWII, make up about 25% of the Robert Stuart Aeronautical Collection of Intelligence and Military artefacts. Robert died several years ago and his daughter Deidre is selling the entire collection.

Camp X overlooking Lake Ontario was a 111-hectare spy training camp, started in 1941 by Winnipeg's own Sir William Stephenson, a WW1 pilot, Distinguished Flying Cross recipient, entrepreneur and British Commonwealth Patriot, or as Prime Minister, Winston Churchill code named him Intrepid.
